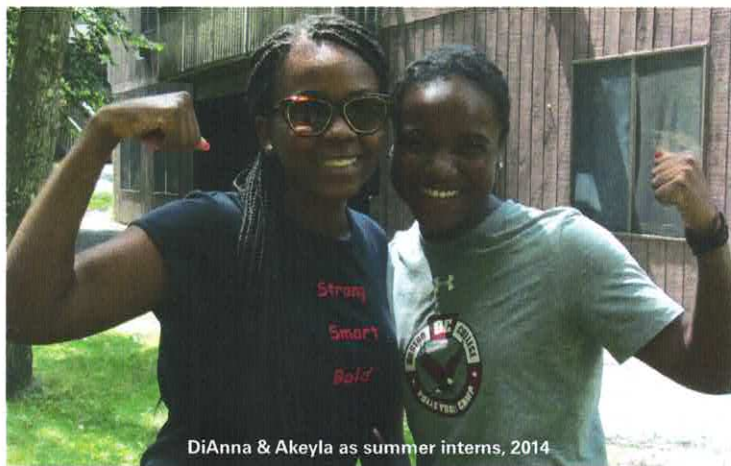

What kind of difference does Girls Inc. make? Meet some of our alumnae and see for yourself what it means when the strong, smart and bold in Westchester girls is inspired, recognized, and celebrated. When girls are given the tools, confidence and support they need to realize their potential, watch out world!

In Westchester, the Girls Inc. difference is tangible and life-changing. Since first becoming eligible for Girls Inc. National Scholarships in 2014, Girls Inc. Westchester has had 6 of its graduates awarded a total of \$90,000 in college scholarships. Girls Inc. Westchester was the youngest of 90 affiliates nationwide to have a \$20,000 scholar two years in a row, and in 2015 it was one of only two affiliates to receive 4 alumnae scholarships, including one who received the highest amount awarded.
